

Terry Sullivan Cup Rules:

1. Nundah Sharks would like to welcome both Wilston Crocs and Virginia State Schools Swim clubs to this swim meet being held on Saturday 3rd December 2016, at the Nundah Sharks Swimming Club, Bage St Nundah.

2. Our aim in the organisation of this carnival is to;

- (a) give Club members who do not usually have the opportunity to represent their Club this chance
- (b) encourage these members to improve their efforts, and to develop greater awareness of Club involvement.

3. As a top priority for this carnival is participation, a ribbon will be given to all competitors. 1st, 2nd, 3rd and participation ribbons to 4th, 5th and 6th swimmers. A replica of the trophy sponsored by Mr Terry Sullivan MLA will be awarded to the Club obtaining the highest points overall.

4. Selection Criteria

- (a) Age Group – 7 years and under to 14 years.
- (b) Age will be calculated according to year of birth.

5. Distances

- (a) 7 Years and Under – 25m Freestyle and Breaststroke ONLY
- (b) 8 years - 25m All Strokes
- (c) 9 years - 50m Freestyle and 25m Other Strokes
- (d) 10 years - 25m Butterfly and 50m Other Strokes
- (e) 11 to 14 years - 50m All Strokes

6. The general criteria for selection will be

- (a) To drop the top two swimmers from each age group.
- (b) In the event that 3rd & 4th swimmers are not available, then the 5th, 6th 7th and so on swimmers are to be selected.

7. If any club has only two (2) swimmers in any age group, then those swimmers may be selected.

8. Competitors may swim up but not more than once in any stroke. Once a swimmer swims up he may not swim back down.

9. No diving at the shallow end of the pool. Relay swimmers starting at the shallow end, will do so from in the water.

10. Swimming Caps must be worn in the water at all times.

11. All fastest times at this meet will establish records for this carnival only. Records will be recorded for all future meets in the Carnival Book.

12. All swimmers have the age group in which they are swimming written in text at least 5cm high on the right arm near the shoulder. When a swimmer swims up in age, the number be crossed out and the new age group written under the original number. This is so the judges can clearly see the age on each swimmer.
